INQUIRIES FROM MEMBER CLUBS

2 similar queries over the past month summarised as one below.

A person residing interstate but has a historic vehicle garaged in Queensland. This person wishes to register the car in Queensland on SIV registration but remain a member of an interstate car club.

Answer from TMR:-

A historic vehicle garaged in Queensland but owned by a person residing interstate may be registered on SIV registration providing the following criteria is met.

1/ The person must become a member of a Car Club incorporated in Queensland.

2/ The following Transport department forms must be lodged with TMR.

A/ Notification of garaging address

B/ Application for a TMR Customer Reference Number (CRN) (Queensland residents use their drivers license number as a CRN)

DATING CERTIFICATES

There has been some confusion of late over Dating certificates with TMR changing the guidelines as of 1 July to accept other documents. I had initially presented an alternative document, SIVS Eligibility certificate but some clubs expressed concern about changing the name of the certificate and in fact the title of Dating officer within clubs. TMR will now accept a document containing vehicle and membership details as long as the document has Club letterhead and is signed by a club official. As a result I have gone back to the attached Document 'Historic Dating and Membership Certificate' .

I have revamped the dating certificate to provide more space for Club name and member address entry so that this is now a very user friendly document.

It is requested that Clubs adopt this document as it covers all criteria for SIVS eligibility as well as capturing vehicle and owner details for club records. This form may be downloaded from the QHMC website www.qhmc.org.au

Note:- This is a 'word ' document so it is easy to add your club letterhead and logo to the top of the document. If you are having difficulty in doing this please email secretary@qhmc.org.au and Russell will place your letterhead and logo on the top of the Dating Certificate.
