MOCC Meeting 13 March 2018 (Motoring and Car Club)

Reduced age requirement for historic buses

Policy and legislative work required to reduce the age from 30 years to 25 years is progressing and it is estimated that changes will come into effect before June 2018.

Registration fees for SIVS motorcycles

TMR advised that following representations, reduced fees will apply to SIVS registered motorcycles from 1 July 2018.

- Owners will pay \$34.20 for registration fees, a reduction of \$60.95 compared to the standard rate of \$94.95
- Renewal registration notices for eligible motorcycles will be sent out from mid - May for registrations with a due date of 1 July 2018

A delegate reported that additional requirements for registration were asked by a Department of Transport office. Items requested;

- Letter from the club stating that the vehicle is of interest to the club the person – the person applying for the registration had a letter from the club – therefore it was considered the club had already endorsed the application via the dating letter and accepting membership
- Also asked for a membership card showing the membership card, membership number, expiry date of club membership and details of the car.
