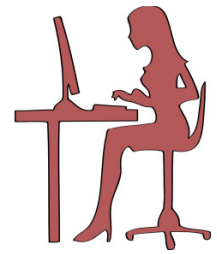




FROM THE PRESIDENTS DESK...



Summary of the QHMC General Meeting Thursday 27th November 2014

1. DTMR

- When issuing a Dating Certificate, photos and statements could be accepted in extenuating circumstances **only**, providing the Dating Officer is satisfied with the documentation provided. A Dating Officer or Club Official **must** still inspect vehicle when reasonable to do so.
