TMR matters has been reasonably quiet for the past month with several matters of SIVS vehicle eligibility and vehicle identification being clarified for members.

Rod Graydon sought clarification from TMR (Transport and Main Roads ) re Dating Inspections and received the following reply.

---

*Dear members,*

*Following advice recently received, I wish to confirm dating certificate inspection requirements.*

*As you may recall, the dating certificate inspection process was discussed at the Motoring Organisation and Car Club (MOCC) meeting held in June 2014.*

*It was noted that inspections can often be difficult to conduct when the vehicle is located in rural Queensland.*

*As such, it was agreed that when issuing a dating certificate, photographs and statements could be accepted in extenuating circumstances **only** (providing the dating officer is satisfied with the documentation provided).*

*However, a dating officer or club official **must** still inspect the vehicle when reasonable to do so.*

*Please ensure your associated clubs are aware of these requirements.*

*I trust this information provides clarification, however if you require further information, please do not hesitate to contact me.*
