Kevin Eeles presented the above Treasurer's monthly report, moved adoption & bills approved for payment.

Seconded: Chris Pike. Carried.

Department of Transport & Main Roads (ex Queensland Transport) Report: Rod Graydon (Sunbeam) said that he has further developed his existing points of contact within DTMR to help resolve registration problems. Guidelines for re-registration of vehicles (SIVS and full rego) currently being rewritten. Rod is in consultation on the matter.

The President briefed the delegates on the agenda items raised at the last DTMR quarterly liaison meeting. These items were listed in full in the minutes of our Management Committee Meeting 25th June 2009 and a brief resume appeared in 'Council News' for June.

President's Note: DTMR came back to us in early August on the issue of 'maintenance road testing'. Happy to report that DTMR confirmed as follows: "maintaining a vehicle prior to an event would be in line with the approved (SIVS) usage (guideline) *preparing for, proceeding to, and returning from the above activities*". Your committee is satisfied with this response. Please direct any further questions to your committee.

Australian Historic Motoring Federation Report: Christine Stevens reported that she is developing the agenda for the AGM to held in September. Christine asked that the authors of any requests to include agenda items ensure that the items are of national significance.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

Dating Certificate. During 2008, QHMC submitted a suggested SIVS dating certificate to DTMR to avoid difficulties experienced by some members of our affiliated clubs when applying for SIVS registration. DTMR has now approved our dating certificate which clearly identifies the vehicle and also provides for SIVS guidelines to be issued to the applicant by their club dating officer. QHMC recommends that clubs adopt the certificate.

RACQ HMC Rally. Planning is well underway for the RACQ HMC Rally to be hosted by **Bundaberg** in June 2010. **The DDVVMC** (Toowoomba) has also commenced its planning for the 2011 RACQ HMC Rally.

Public Liability Insurance. All clubs should now have their PLI Insurance (clubs need to contact Austnet Insurance, PO Box 8063, Angelo St, South Perth, 6151.PH 0894738600, FAX 0894738611) if they have not received renewals.

AGM September. QHMC will hold its first AGM after the monthly general meeting on 24th September. The current Secretary will not be standing for re-election, nor will the current Treasurer. All committee positions will be declared vacant and nominations will be required for all positions. This is a chance for any affiliated club member, existing delegate or not, to help lead the peak motoring body catering for historic vehicles in Queensland. All clubs are asked to canvass their members to identify anyone interested in accepting a QHMC committee position.

Nomination forms were available at the meeting.

Honararium to Secretary. This issue gave rise to positive discussion. Delegates were supportive of a proposal that a payment be made to all future secretaries in order to go part way in covering their out-of-pocket expenses for stationery and other items. The efforts that a secretary makes to ensure the smooth running of QHMC were unanimously acknowledged.

It was proposed: That in future, QHMC pay the Secretary \$500 (five hundred dollars) p.a. to partially compensate for out-of-pocket expenses. To be paid half yearly at \$250 each six months. Proposed: Christine Stevens (Morgan Owners). Seconded: Doug Beatton (VVCAA). Carried: unanimously.

It was proposed: That the current secretary, Richard Egglesfield, be paid \$500 (five hundred dollars) retrospectively for the 2008/09 committee year. Proposed: Christine Stevens. Seconded: John Green (Mustang Owners Club). Carried: unanimously

NOTE: The by-laws in Handbook need to be amended to reflect this payment on an 'on-going basis'.

Vote of Thanks: The President thanked Albert Budworth for agreeing to represent the Combined Council at the 2009 RACQ CC Rally held at Bribie Island and organised by the QVVA. He thanked QVVA for organising the rally.

QHMC trophies. Trophies for eligible events are in stock. Clubs need to ask for them. Two trophies were handed to LAMA delegates – one for Tractor Trek and one for the LAMA October Rally.
