Kevin Eeles presented the monthly report and moved that the report be adopted & bills approved for payment. Seconded: Rick A'bell; Carried.

Treasurer also briefed the delegates on the rationale for a recent review carried out on QHMC affiliation fees. John Green moved that fees for the next 12 months remain the same as at present; Seconded Fred Clark; Carried.

Department of Transport & Main Roads / Queensland Transport Report: Rod Graydon touched on the implications and possible actions re the aspect of 'Authenticity' in a dating certificate. Rod distributed copies of his Security Paper and briefed the meeting on its contents, which was very well received by the delegates.

Australian Historic Motoring Federation Update QHMC has received copies of the mid-year update of AGM action items. Status of progress is not recorded against AGM action points as listed in the minutes, and should be. QHMC is not satisfied with progress on some action items. Whilst AHMF President promptly sought answers from government on the pre-1989 import restrictions issue, progress to engage with ASRF to address draconian import rules with government is uncertain. The meeting was advised that items for inclusion in this year's AGM Agenda need to be submitted to AHMF this month.

Calendar of Events: The QHMC events calendar has been updated on the website http://www.qhmc.org.au/calendar.htm and links have been added to any flyers or entry forms for events provided by all clubs. Richard also advised that clubs can use a form on the events webpage to advise QHMC of any new events or details of events to Tom Lewis as has always been the case.

Web update: All event flyers and rally entry forms forwarded that have been forwarded to QHMC either via Tom Lewis or emailed to the Webmaster are all loaded to the QHMC website. This month a few clubs advised that they now have Websites and hyperlinks have been added from the QHMC site to the club websites. Any club that has a website should check the QHMC website's list of affiliated clubs to see if a link exists and, if not, consider asking for one to be added.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

Business from Action Points:

AHMF Survey. David James agreed to act as State co-ordinator for the survey to collate the emailed and posted returns.

Veteran Rego Agreed the need to form a sub committee to develop a business case for submission to the State Government (TMR) and potentially the Qld Minister for Transport and the Qld Minister responsible for Heritage. Bill Martin and Rod Graydon agreed to work on the sub committee.

AHMF AGM Agenda. Several suggested items were prepared by the Sec prior to the GM. These ideas were debated. Delegates were also asked to provide further items for discussion. Agenda items will therefore be drawn up as follows: examine rules for AHMF committee nominations; policy on AHMF promotional activities; although delegates reaffirmed their decision to not object to the recently introduced seat belt laws they agreed that on a national front we should ask for exemptions re seat belt requirements for under 16s during processions and parades; honorariums for committee members; education of members re Ethanol enhanced petrol; Lay out of AGM Minutes, numbering of Minute items, follow up on action items; pursue liaison with ASRF re importation of pre-1989 vehicles.

Business arising from correspondence:

The meeting expressed disappointment at the extent of unfinished action items from 2009 AGM Minutes based on mid-year review of performance.

Rod Graydon volunteered to act as proxy delegate for Maryborough District Antique Motor Club.

President is in touch with Roma Club and should have Roma country liaison visit completed in early July.

There were no issues raised in relation to public liability insurance and all are happy with current arrangements.

NMHD (16th May 10) Reports: LAMA conducted its swap at Gatton; Bayside VRC conducted a run through southern suburbs of Brisbane ending in a static display at Fort Lytton National Park and a guided tour of the fort; SCACC conducted its Motorkhana but we have no details; events also conducted by Hervey Bay, Buick, Cadillac, Darling Downs, and several clubs on Tamborine Mtn, but no details. It was a slightly overcast day in Brisbane but there was not any rain to spoil the day.

Clubs are asked to suggest plans at the July GM for conducting NMHD next year.

Your views are important to the future of the movement so please consider completing the survey, and it will take no more than 25 minutes of your time.

Changes to Pre 1989 Vehicle Import Scheme.

The government are tightening the application of the rules which apply to importing pre 1989 vehicles. The changes effect modified vehicles. The current application of the rules is that if a vehicle has been modified then the importer must prove that the modifications were carried out before 1989, If the importer can not prove the modifications were carried our prior to 1989 then the vehicle can not be imported under the pre 1989 scheme. This is because the government department considers that the date of manufacture of a vehicle, is the date that the vehicle was modified. While the stated intention is to stop the importation of modified "Hot-rods" type vehicles the rules state that a "modifications. If you are considering importing a Veteran / Vintage / Post Vintage / Historic Vehicle check that the proposed vehicle complies with the rules before you try to import it. The Department has added a new bulletin which outlines the "new" import rules for pre 1989 vehicles. This bulletin is available from the Infrastructure Department's website at:-
