Graham Simpson presented the financial report and moved that it be adopted and bills approved for payment. Seconded by Doug Beatton. Carried.

Graham explained that in accordance with the approved motion in item 3.1 in November 2010 Minutes, \$6,000 has been taken from trading account and placed into a term deposit as shown above.

- **3.2** *Department of Transport & Main Roads Report:* Presented by QHMC Transport Liaison Officer Rod Graydon. Quarterly liaison meeting on 30<sup>th</sup> Nov 2010 attended by R. Graydon, D. James and G. Bristow.
  - **3.2.1 Dating Certificate** DTMR was briefed on changes made to dating certificate in order to satisfy DTMR requirements. When finalised, all clubs will be encouraged to use the approved dating certificate. QHMC has undertaken to promote the use of the standard dating certificate when it is finally approved by DTMR.

- 3.2.2 Seat Belts and Child Restraints as mandated in Qld Road Rules. QHMC remains focused on age 7 to under 16 exemptions, historic vehicle exemptions, and is engaged directly with the DTMR branch that makes road rules recommendations to the minister. Late News: Since our Jan 2011 GM, Pres and Past Sec have met with DTMR senior officers for an initial conference as a result of our submission. Further research and review needs to be done before our submission proceeds and liaison will continue until we reach a conclusion.
- **3.2.3 Veteran Rego Project.** Some feedback received, the project is taking shape. More submissions requested please.
- **3.3** *Australian Historic Motoring Federation:* AHMF not yet approached re the ATO tax on clubs earning over \$416. QHMC committee will soon review current AHMF Action Items in order to seek a status report.

#### 4. GENERAL BUSINESS:

#### 4.1 Business from Action Points:

- **4.1.1 Ethanol Fuels.** Old Govt mandate for the introduction of ethanol has been postponed 12 months. On 30<sup>th</sup> November 2010, QHMC attended a conference at the Office of Clean Energy as a result of a submission raised by our 2009/10 Secretary. Negative effect on regional tourism (historic vehicle rallies in country towns) cited as an outcome of the government's ill-conceived stalled ethanol mandate. Awaiting further consultation. No tangible outcomes at this early stage.
- **4.1.2 \$416 Income Tax threshold.** QHMC will be approaching AHMF with a view to lobbying for an increase in the \$416 income tax threshold for clubs such as historic vehicle clubs. X ref to Minute 3.3.
- **4.1.3 Training of Club Committee Members.** Clubs were asked in the Nov 2010 Minutes (Minute item 4.3.2 Nov 2010) to provide comment as to whether a short training training/development course for prospective and existing committee people would receive club support. Nil response to date.
- **4.1.4 Handbook Update/Review (Major Rally section)**. Input from BundabergVVC and DDMVCC requested in Nov Minutes, item 1.4, to provide input to the revision and updating of the section on conducting a major rally. Nil response received to date.
- **4.1.5 Handbook Update/Review (History section).** Details requested from anyone at all to show as much detail as possible on QHMC/CC Rally results and details of past Management committee members.
- **4.1.6 Handbook Update/Review (amendments generally).** All Clubs were asked in Nov 2010 Minutes (Minute 1.6) to review the QHMC handbook (download from QHMC Web site) and provide details of any changes the clubs recommend. Nil responses to date.
- **4.1.7 QHMC Promotion.** Ads discontinued during rain and floods. Will resume in near future.
- **4.1.8 Veteran No-Cost Rego Project.** Sub committee work progressing (Rod Graydon & Bill Martin) We need a few more submissions please.
- **4.1.9** Naming rights sponsor for HMC rallies beyond 2011. Awaiting response from RACQ. List of possible replacement sponsors compiled.
- **4.1.10 Seat Belt & Child Restraints Legislation.** QHMC Bulletin No. 1 of 2010 issued nationally. Detailed letter sent to senior DTMR officer 28<sup>th</sup> October 2010. Response received; policy officers directed to review and report back.. See Minute 3.2 for details.
- **4.1.11 Dating Certificate.** Discussed at DTMR Liaison Meeting on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2010. We are close to an outcome and should have it resolved at next liaison meeting.

#### 4.3 Other General Business

- **4.3.1National Motoring Heritage Day.** QHMC needs details of club's activities for NMHD to load onto the QHMC website. So far: Bayside Vehicle Restorers Club displaying at Ormiston House, Triumph Sports Owners Assn major classic and sports activity at Lakeside Park motor racing circuit (Maclean Bridge at Lakeside), and Bundaberg V&V Club display in Bundaberg.
- **4.3.2 Victoria Club Permit Scheme**. Noted that 45/90 day logbook scheme commenced 1st February 2011.

- **4.3.3 Robert Shannon Foundation.** The foundation encourages people under 30 to restore or preserve 30+ year old club vehicles. Awards can assist in the purchase of nomination details, see the QHMC website.

Seat Belt & Child Restraint Laws - Update: This is an update and ongoing reminder of this important news item: New Queensland Road Rules (QRR) introduced in 2010. Seat belts and child restraints are in Sections 266 (rules) and 267 (exemptions). Website link: <a href="http://www.legislation.qld.gov.au/LEGISLTN/CURRENT/T/TrantOpRURR09.pdf">http://www.legislation.qld.gov.au/LEGISLTN/CURRENT/T/TrantOpRURR09.pdf</a>
Unlike as provided for in the Australian Road Rules and the rules of every other State, the Qld Govt decided to go it alone by failing to provide a seat belt exemption in our old cars for children aged 7 to under 16 years of age. Qld Govt has made it illegal to carry them in <a href="mailto:any">any</a> vehicle not fitted with belts. QHMC is advocating for parity with the Australian Road Rules as done in other States and has advocated on behalf of clubs to the Qld Govt for it to conduct a review of the matter. QHMC Information Bulletin No. 1 of 2010 explains the situation in more detail. In addition, South Australia has already given historic club vehicles driven in that State a blanket exemption and QHMC has asked for similar provisions here in Queensland. Senior DTMR management has assured QHMC that the matter is now under review. Face-to-face consultation occurred in early February 2011 and is ongoing. QHMC will keep the movement informed as the matter progresses.

**No-cost registration for Veterans:** A QHMC sub committee is in the club consultation phase of this project and working towards developing a business case advocating for no-cost registration for Veteran vehicles. The sub committee will also consider when a 100 year rolling date might be appropriate for such a scheme. QHMC has requested more submissions from interested clubs and their members at <a href="mailto:secretary@qhmc.org.au">secretary@qhmc.org.au</a> or by writing to QHMC at 1376 Old Cleveland Rd Carindale 4152.
