## TMR REPORT Presented by Albert Budworth

TMR Officers have met regularly. Albert read a drafted letter address to the Hon. Mark Bailey, Minister for Transport advising of the problems since the report on the Inquiry into Motor Recreational Activities and the forming of the Recreational Motor Vehicle and Safety Group, and a letter to the previous MOCC individual clubs delegates that form the group as there is many issues that need to be discussed and are not addressed in the RMVSG Meeting. The meeting was held on the 16th April and received minutes on the 22nd June which did not reflect the meeting discussion, and of little interest to the historic movement. When contacted TMR was advised to add to the Agenda for the next meeting. There is several issues that previous MOCC group want discussion on. Plan is that a person from the MOCC group attend the RMVSG meeting. A discussion followed, with several delegates having input and perhaps leave the draft letter till after the next RMVSG meeting. As 4WD vehicles dominated the meeting, remember there are 4WDs in the Historic Movement. Next meeting is on 27th August 2021.

Affiliation Fees for 2022 to 2023 was advised. A Total Restructuring of the Fees for a fairer and simpler system instead of the sliding scale. New system proposed, \$1 per club member. Minimum cap at \$30 and Maximum cap at \$200.

This new system will be tabled and voted on at the AGM.

A delegate asked about a member using concessional registered vehicle when not a member of a club. Reply was that it is a Police matter.

Victorian Government is reviewing Special Interest Vehicle Scheme.

Delegates complained about club members not abiding by the Impromptu Events Ruling.

A delegate asked about registration fees on Veteran Vehicles, could this be cheaper replied that this is a continuing work in process.
