TMR REPORT Presented by Albert Budworth

The issue raised by a delegate of the Roma Historical Motor Club (where outside organisations are asking clubs and individuals to supply their SIV Registered vehicle for functions, for payment) is being investigated by TMR. This may not be an issue if a vehicle is on full Registration.

Clubs and members are advised to be fully aware of the conditions of their Special Interest Vehicle Registration. The link to these conditions is: www.tmr.qld.gov.au , search for *Concessional Registration*, then *Special Interest Vehicle Scheme*.

The date of the Veteran Car Club of Australia swap meet to be held at the Carindale rooms site, has been changed from the 19th to the 26 August.

Member clubs are reminded QHMC Affiliation fees payments are due on 1 July. Annual Affiliation fees are presented at the bottom of the Renewal form. A copy of the form is attached.

In situations where members with SIV Registered vehicles leave a club but retain SIV Registration, they are in breach of SIV conditions and responsibility rests with them. It is not the responsibility of a club to chase them up (but it may choose to do so)

The Australian Historical Motoring Federation is conducting a survey of heritage vehicle owners to ascertain the contribution that the heritage vehicle sector, both classic and historic, makes to the Australian economy. Your club can expect to receive a questionnaire from 7 July. QHMC members clubs are requested to complete the survey, on line, by 31 August. This survey involves the motoring councils in each and all States.

A delegate of Lockyer Antique Motor Association has inquired into changing the limited use of tractor Registration to SIV. Albert to investigate.

The President has received an assurance from the Qld Government that petrol will be available indefinitely.

He also mentioned that Toyota is moving to produce hydrogen powered vehicles. Electric vehicle prices are coming down quickly, roof racks and towing with an EV are issues. A delegate reported on the Brisbane Truck Show where more than half the trucks are going electric. Another delegate reported on the success of the RACQ Motorfest with 468 vehicles, it was widely and well accepted.
