.A Zoom meeting was held with AHMF. There was discussion around trucks on concessional Registration, where different States have different load requirements based on GCM or GVM; NSW – no load permitted, Qld with 50% and SA with no limit, the aim is to standardise across all States. In SA, kit cars can be Registered on a concessional basis

**TMR REPORT:** Presented by Albert Budworth

There has been correspondence back and forth with Darling Downs Veteran and Vintage Motor Club, use of a vehicle on concessional Registration is permissible for a school event, but not for a school formal (where only immediate family members can participate).
