NEW STANDARD NUMBER PLATES

After 30 years, DTMR has exhausted the current number plate numbering system and a new number plate numbering system is now being introduced. The new ones will continue to be maroon on a white background together with three numbers, two letters and one number. An example is shown below. This configuration will allow for 16 million unique numbers, enough for the next 25 years of Registrations. There is also a security code built into these number plates, this is not directly visible

when viewed directly, but from the side. This is designed to identify fake plates. The new plate will in the new series will start with 000 AA0.

NEW CHAPTER 11 for CONSTITUTION

WHEN DELEGATE MEMBERSHIP ENDS

There will be no talking over other delegates or interjections, no video- taping, no troublesome behaviour

and if uncooperative with direction from the management committee, that person will be removed immediately from the meeting and future meetings for a period of 60 days

The management committee may terminate the attendance and participation of a member's club delegate, if that delegate conducts himself, or herself in a way considered to be injurious or prejudicial to the character or interest of the Association.

The member club has the rights to appoint a replacement delegate.
