Did you Know?

1 in 5 motor vehicle accidents are caused by fatigue.

If a driver falls asleep for just 4 seconds while travelling at 100 km/hr the car will have travelled 111 meters without a driver in control.

Drivers who have slept 4-5 hours in the past 24 hours are 4.5 times more likely to crash than drivers who have slept 7 hours or more.

That is why all of us need to be aware of the effects of fatigue on our ability to concentrate.
